Members of the public need to sign up in advance to give their comments.

- Speakers will give their comments in the order in which they signed up.
- Speakers are limited to 3 minutes per comment.
- Public comment is limited to 12 minutes in total.

The CAC co-chair has the right to shorten the time given to each speaker. The CAC co-chair may also extend the time given for public comment.
