

## **CCO Advisory Councils Report to the Governing Board**January 2016

## **Community Advisory Council:**

The Community Advisory Committee (CAC) met on Monday, January 25<sup>th</sup> at Lane County Youth Services. There was public comment by Drake Ewbanks who is representing the Lane County (Mental Health) Advisory Council. He will be attending the meetings and sharing information between the two goups.

The "getting to know you" question was "what was your dream job when you were a child?"

Debi Farr gave the Trillium report. Lucy Zammarelli gave a report on the Transformation plan. She focused on the Health Equity section of the plan and shared the goals and results so far. Rick Kincade reported on the CAP. He shared information about the lack of providers who are able and willing to do colonoscopies for the Trillium population. Char Reavis reported on the RAC (see above.)

Char also brought up the fact that the State Transformation Center is not planning any summits this year. The CAC members who have attended previous Summits expressed that they found them very valuable. There was concern that there would not be sufficient support for CAC members, especially consumer members. Members who have attended also expressed the value of meeting and working with members from other CACs. It was suggested that perhaps the CCOs could consider sponsoring such trainings. The Trillium CAC would like to ask the Governing Board to consider what action it could take to support ongoing training and networking among CAC members across the state.

Paige Hamm presented the new Trillium Mission and Vision, The CAC members voted to approve the new Mission and Vision.

Jennifer Webster gave a report on the Prevention programs that the CAC supports. The lively presentation included an exercise from the CATCH program. (see attached)
