

CCO Advisory Councils Report to the Governing Board June 2016

Community Advisory Council (CAC):

The CAC met on Monday June 27th at Lane County Youth Services. Susana Samis gave public comment for NAMI, reporting that there is a new peer support group being offered. Debi Farr gave the Trillium report. There was some discussion around the recent newspaper article regarding the Centene/Trillium merger. Debi answered questions and reminded members that the services Trillium offers are defined by OHP. Trillium provided the services required and went beyond those obligations to invest millions in the community. People were generally supportive.

Lucy gave an update on Trillium's diversity and equity work, including a report on the recent Equity Coalition event. Over 130 people attended that event, watched a video on the impact of race on health and held discussions. Each attendee was asked to commit to bringing these discussions into their workplaces and communities. Rick Kincade reported from the CAP.

Jennifer Webster presented on the prevention program CATCH. Please see attached report.

Leah Edelman presented the 2016 CHIP Progress report. The report was approved and sent to Trillium.

Karen Gaffney presented the 2016 CHIP and responded to questions. Members were asked if they had participated in any stage of the development of the CHIP. All CAC members responded that they had participated. The CHIP was approved unanimously and will be referred to the Trillium Governing Board.
